

How to Build a Hummingbird Garden

Hummingbirds pollinate the flowers, which means they transfer pollen from flower to flower in order to create more seeds, so more flowers can grow!

Here are some tips for your own garden!

1. Pick a good spot that you can see! You can use trees, sheds or shelves.
2. Use native flowers. Ruby-throated hummingbirds are attracted to flowers such as cardinal flowers and trumpet honeysuckles.
3. Leave dandelions and thistle in your yard so the birds can use them for nests.
4. Add bird baths.
5. Don't use pesticides!
