

Paper Japanese Screen

Japanese screens are translucent folding screens that divides a room for privacy but also lets light through. These screens (called shoji screens) began in China in as early as 300 B.C., but were adapted in Japan to be lighter and easier to transport.

Materials: Marker, coloring utensils, paper

1. Color your paper like a screen! Separate it into as many panels as you want and copy the design to the right or make your own!





2. Fold your screen like an accordian so it stands up!
